The Healthy and Natural State

Since February 2010, Stephan König, together with his partner Brigitte Kraus, has been a «Member of QUANTEC® Consulting» and represented there with interesting cases (www.quantec.eu).

In the initial phase of his work with QUANTEC®, he sought visible confirmation of its effectiveness. Thus, he began, among other things, treating potted plants that had been in his possession for about 10 years.

He has compiled and documented the development within the last four years.

It's quite astonishing what changes and developments are possible through the use of QUANTEC®. With this report, I aim to demonstrate that promoting a healthy and natural state is entirely realistic.

The initial situation was as follows: in the mid-90s, I was gifted a citrus and an orange sapling. At that time, they were about 60 cm tall and seemed quite healthy. Since the new location near Bayreuth does not really match the natural conditions for citrus plants, I was curious to see how they would develop. The care regime over the entire period of about 15 years did not change and was limited to

- limited to watering with good water,
- bi-weekly light fertilization during the growth period,
- and as short a wintering phase as possible (cool, not too dark).

Over the next 10 years, the following became clear:

The citrus sapling bloomed a bit each year, but only bore fruit once in 2003. The orange sapling did not even bloom. Both had a really very sunny location and good overwintering. However, both lost all their leaves during the winter break – every year. The growth of both plants was only minimal and barely noticeable over the years, and their health condition deteriorated more and more despite good care. It could be said: It was a time of survival and not, ideally, a time of growth and flourishing.

Now begins the interesting time – the time with QUANTEC[®]!

In spring 2007, we purchased a small citrus sapling about 30 cm tall. This is shown in picture 1 on page 2 and we began in May 2007 to promote the natural growth of all three plants with the help of QUANTEC®. I would like to show and clarify this development until autumn 2011 through some pictures.


Conclusion

Even if a visible change does not always occur immediately, the fruits show very clearly if one has a little patience – not only in nature. For me, this example illustrates even more: The growth of the «small» citrus sapling was encouraged from the beginning and thus shows a more significant extent.

The two saplings, which had been stunted for several years, have now significantly recovered and are thriving again in a natural way.
